Financial Aid Renewal!

It's that time again: **FINANCIAL AID RENEWAL! YAY!!!**

As you may be aware, every year you need to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Each state has a different deadline, and Michigan has a March 1, 2016 deadline.

Please visit the Financial Aid Office by the Library to see what you need to do to complete the FAFSA by March 1. You can import your tax information to the FAFSA to make the process relatively pain-free.

If you delay on completing the FAFSA, you may lose out or have a reduced amount of financial aid. DO NOT LET THIS IMPORTANT TASK GET AWAY FROM YOU!!!
