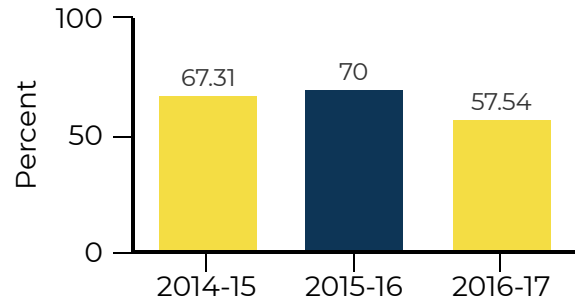

SSS Graduation Rates by Cohort Year



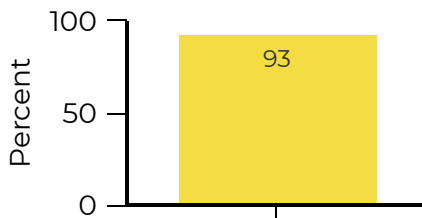
Cohort refers to a group of students who began their education at the same time. Most students graduate in 4-6 years.

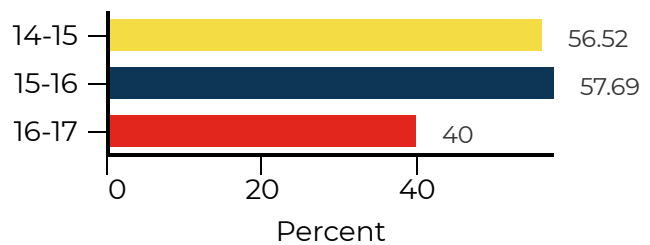

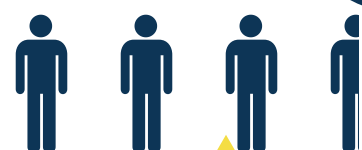
